Job Creation

Create jobs by supporting inclusive export growth, particularly for women and youth, in key export value chains such as agriculture and cotton, textile, and garments (CTG).



Capacity Development to Facilitate Trade

Facilitate trade by strengthening the capacity of national and regional bodies to widen and deepen regional integration in the framework of the African Continental Free Trade Agreement (AfCFTA) and the regional economic communities.



Economic Resilience

Strengthen resilience against shocks by supporting vulnerable groups, such as women traders and young entrepreneurs, facilitating more effective delivery and sourcing of humanitarian aid, and making food more affordable.

ERRA is a demand-driven program working with local partners to empower and strengthen institutional capacities to engender local ownership and sustainability.

Gender and Youth
